3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, was born of the virgin Mary, and that is true God and true man. Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18-25; Colossians 2:9

4. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death, which is separation from God, and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are therefore under just condemnation to eternal ruin without defense or excuse.
